

## Men's Basketball Sports Code

1. RULES-Official NJCAA and NCAA rules and regulations will govern play unless specifically over-ridden by the MCCAC bylaws.
2. CONFERENCE FORMAT- Divisional distinctions of NJCAA Division 1 and 2 guide the conference schedule. Division 1 MCCAC conference members will play other Division 1 schools twice and will play Division 2 schools once within the MCCAC conference. Conversely Division 2 MCCAC members will play Division 2 schools twice and play Division 1 schools once.
3. SCHEDULING- It is the responsibility of each MCCAC member coach to schedule conference games.
4. OFFICIALS- The MCCAC employs an assignment coordinator. It is the responsibility of the Officials Coordinator to supply highly qualified referees for every MCCAC conference game. A fee structure for a 3 man referee crew will be negotiated and determined.
5. DETERMINING THE CONFERENCE CHAMPION- The highest winning percentage will determine the champion. Teams that share the highest winning percentage will be awarded co-champion status.
6. ALL CONFERENCE TEAM- The All Conference Team will be determined by a coach's vote. Those procedures are as follows:
  - a. Each coach will nominate the players they wish to be considered. There is no limit on the number of players that can be nominated.
  - b. Each coach will then complete a blind ballot and vote for the 10 players he believes to be worthy. A coach may not vote for the players that he nominated. The coach or his representative must be present for the nomination and voting procedure meeting. This meeting is traditionally held in late February at Jefferson College.
  - c. The 10 players receiving the most votes from the coaches will be named to the All Conference team. In the event that more than 10 players would tie for All Conference votes additional All Conference players can be named to the All Conference Team. Other players that receive votes will be named to the Honorable Mention Team.
7. COACH OF THE YEAR- Coach of the Year is also determined by a coach's vote.
8. AWARDS- Each All Conference Player and Coach of the Year will receive a plaque. Honorable Mention recipients will receive certificates. The team champion will receive a plaque.
9. TEAM SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD- Coaches will also vote to award one MCCAC team a Sportsmanship award. Voting will take place at the All Conference voting meeting in February.
10. SPORTSMANSHIP- Men's Basketball abides by the NJCAA Sportsmanship policies. Please refer to those policies for further information.
