

Women's Basketball Sports Code

I. Schedule

- A. A master schedule is made and every year the last set of games from the previous year will rotate to the first games the next year.
- B. Games will be scheduled on Wednesday night and can be played during both semesters.
- C. Scheduled games may be changed and played on any day and/or time with consent of both coaches.
- D. The conference schedule is to be set at the meeting to determine All Conference selections.

II. Officials

- A. An officials' coordinator is employed by the conference
- B. It is the coordinators responsibility to supply high qualified referees for every conference game
- C. A fee structure for a three man crew will be negotiated and determined

III. Team Championship

- A. Division 1 teams will play each other twice (home/away) and the Division 2 teams once on a rotating basis (home one year, away the next)
- B. Division 2 teams will play each other twice (home/away) and the division 1 teams once on a rotating basis (home one year away the other)
- C. Format for upcoming years as related to letter A

- D. The champion will be decided by the best winning percentage. If a tie would occur, then co-champions will be awarded.

IV. Individual Honors

- A. All-conference will be done in the following manner: a) coaches may nominate as many players as they wish, b) coaches vote for a ten player team in no specific order, but may not vote for their own, c) the top ten vote getters are all conference (if a tie occurs all student-athletes involved in the tie will be all-conference), d) any player receiving a vote is honorable mention.
- B. With majority approval of the coaches present, a coach may request a student-athlete to be added to the honorable mention list (one per institution).
- C. Coach of the year – each coach present may place a vote for coach of the year. Coach receiving the most votes is coach of the year.
- D. Nominees may be sent with a representative or via fax if a coach is unable to attend the meeting.
- E. Nominees from an institution will be withdrawn from consideration if their coach/representative is not available to vote (i.e. meeting, fax, phone).

V. Sportsmanship Award

- A. Coaches will vote for a team that demonstrated the best sportsmanship through out the season.
- B. The team with most votes will be awarded.
- C. If a tie does occur, then co-sportsmanship awards will be given.
